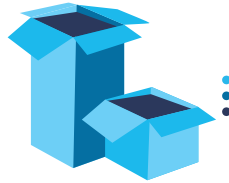


Paper Recycling

Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, and greeting cards. Shredded paper should be put in a clear or paper bag.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Newspaper
- Envelopes
- Junk mail
- Phone books
- Brochures
- Magazines



Cardboard Recycling

Recycle corrugated cardboard and paperboard boxes after removing any plastic or foam inserts, air pillows, and other shipping material.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Ream wrappers (non-plastic)
- File folders
- Poster board
- Frozen food boxes
- Cardboard boxes
- Milk cartons
(Remove liquid or food)



Plastic Recycling

Recycle plastics #1, 2 and 5. Look on the bottom of containers for a number. Do not recycle plastic bags, film, or wrap.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Milk jugs
- Water/Soda containers
- Creamer & condiments bottles
- Cartons
- Plastic food containers
(Remove liquid or food)

Glass Recycling

Recycle clear and colored glass.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Beverage containers
- Glass food jars
(Remove liquid or food)



Aluminum/Metal Recycling

Recycle all food and beverage metal cans - steel, tin, bi-metal and aluminum.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Food cans
- Catering trays
(Remove liquid or food)



WHAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED:

- Plastic Bags
- Bubble Wrap
- Christmas Lights
- Coat Hangers
- Electrical Cords
- Food Wrap
- Polystyrene/ Styrofoam
- Food-soiled paper
- Pallets
- Furniture



ITEMS REQUIRING SPECIAL HANDLING:

These items should never be mixed with regular recycling. Disposal requires special handling.

- Incandescent light bulbs
- Fluorescent tubes
- Computers & Electronics
- Appliances
- Needles or syringes
- Batteries
- Hazardous waste
- Toxic material containers
- Paint
- Green waste/food waste
- Pallets
- Furniture
